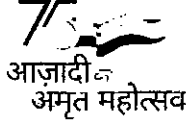

As you must be aware that Hon'ble Chief Minister, Delhi has launched 14 point Summer Action Plan, 2023 against air pollution with effect from 01.05.2023 to be implemented in coordination with various stakeholder departments.

The 14 point Action Summer Plan, 2023 includes following points:-

1. Dust pollution control
2. Industrial pollution control
3. Solid Waste Management
4. Tree Plantation Drive
5. Tree transplantation Policy
6. Real time Source Apportionment Study
7. Prohibition on Open Burning
8. Development of City Forest
9. Urban Farming
10. Development of Jheel/Ponds in Delhi
11. Development of Parks (Harit Park) in Delhi
12. E-waste Eco-park
13. Eco-Club Activities at schools/colleges
14. Coordination with neighbouring State Governments

The objective of above stated Action Plan is improving the ambient air quality in Delhi by maximizing the number of good, moderate and satisfactory days in terms of Ambient Air Quality Index (AQI) during April to September, 2023 and laying the base for actions for improved ambient air quality during critical winter months, Government of NCT of Delhi launches the 14 point Summer Action Plan for mitigating air pollution during the Summer 2023 in consultation with stakeholder departments.

The action plan will be implemented in coordination with more than 30 stakeholder departments namely ULBs, DDA, DSIDC, DPCC, Revenue, DJB, IFCD, CPWD, NHAI, NCRTC, PWD, Delhi Police, Transport Department, Directorate of Education, DPGS, Forest Department, Delhi Fire Services, Horticulture, etc.

With the joint efforts taken by stakeholder departments for controlling air pollution in Delhi during winter 2022, City of Delhi witnessed 160 good, satisfactory and moderate days of air quality in Delhi during this winter, compared to 106 good, satisfactory and moderate days in 2016. This increase in good, satisfactory and moderate days was accompanied by a concurrent decrease in severe and severe+ days in comparison to the last 5 years.

In view of above, may I request you to ensure that officers from your department continue with their diligent and persistent efforts towards air pollution control in Delhi and make the summer Action Plan successful on ground. 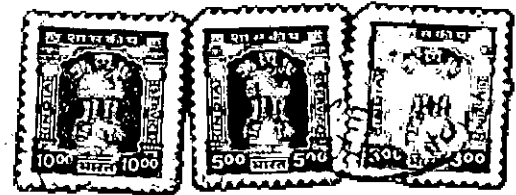
